ANY OTHER ITEMS WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL

Points Suggested by the Academic Council Members

Suggestions by Dr. Gangolu Appa Rao:

- Instead of drop in academic credits the students can be given with awards.
- Instead of issuing photocopy of answer scripts, challenge system of Anna University can be followed.
- MOOC courses based elective credit drop can be allowed.
- Encourage internships with exchange programs and keep publications / GATE score as selection criteria in addition to the CGPA.


Suggestions by Dr. N. Arul Anand:

- Dropping of elective credits based on publications / startups / innovations should be excluded from the regulation as the evaluation is not practical in such cases.
- Attendance for individual courses must be followed for deeming the student eligible or ineligible for appearing for the examinations.
- Evaluation and Question paper setting should be carried out by involving 60% external faculty members and 40% internal faculty members.
- Question paper and answer scripts should be audited for continuous internal assessments and end semester examinations.
- If slow learners are interested, they can carry out the elective courses in advance, before studying program core subjects.

Suggestions by Dr. A. Kunthavai:

- Students could be awarded for publications, patents, startups and innovations instead of dropping elective credits.
- Institution listed online courses should be provided for the students, upon who's completion the students shall drop elective subject credits.

- Semester redo procedure should be included in the regulations and each department should depute a redo coordinator to manage such students.
- The 75% minimum attendance should be made mandatory for individual subjects.
- Photocopy of end semester answer scripts are not to be issued to the students since it might result in legal problems.

Suggestions by Dr. K. Rathnakannan:

- The professional elective vertical should not have any kind of restrictions for the students to choose in any semester.
- Student foreign exchange programs should be included in the regulations the period of duration should be six months and credits shall be offered for the same.
- If students compete all the subjects before eighth semester, they can opt for a full semester internship or industrial project.
- · Consider the transfer of credits into elective subjects from courses studied for Honors and Minor in case of the student dropping Honors or minor.
- Students should be allowed to audit subjects to encourage them to learn more.


- Students should be given with some kind of recognition instead of credit drop.
- Faculty choice by students is good but the wrapper day will affect the choice students would make in the future.

The Academic Council Members approved to follow the Anna University regulations for senior classes. Finally, the Chairman, Academic Council thanked all the members for the fruitful discussion and valuable suggestions and meeting concluded.





In such case these additional credits will not be considered for GPA/CGPA calculations.

5.10 Online Courses

The student shall drop the six credits, provided they have earned through two three credit online courses. The Head of the Institution shall form a three-member committee with members as HOD and a faculty member from the Department, HOD of any other branch of the Institution to ensure that the student has not studied such course and would not repeat it again as Professional core/Professional elective.

These online courses shall be chosen from the SWAYAM platform / MOOC courses with proctored examination. The details regarding online courses taken up by student and marks/credits earned must be sent to the Controller of Examinations in the subsequent semester(s) along with the details of the professional elective to be dropped. Otherwise, credits earned by the students will be indicated in the semester grade sheet as well as in the consolidated grade sheet as additional credits. In such case these additional credits will not be considered for GPA/CGPA calculations.
